*From the Desk of Msgr. Harrington...*

Beginnings and transitions. Change is a sign of the ongoing process and progress of life. To change is to grow, to move beyond our past, to explore and discover new ways of being. Every transition in life is an opportunity of beginning and entering into the creative process with God to redefine ourselves.

The sacrament of Confirmation is a sacrament of initiation, whereby a person is transitioning into a deeper relationship with Jesus and His church. It is a new beginning for a son or daughter of God to clearly hear and know that the breath of God, the Holy Spirit of God confirms His love. Our brothers and sisters soon to be confirmed, we want you to know how profoundly our God loves you. He loves you in darkness and in light. He loves you all throughout your journey. He sees and knows you as beloved and precious in His eyes. He confirms that love for you that He has always had. When He first whispered your name at the dawn of time, when He cradled you in your mother's arms and claimed you as His own, He knew you and loved you.

This confirmed love that God bestows, empowers you with His Spirit to take your place in the church. You were always a member of the church, but now you become an adult in the life of the community of the faithful. That is why it is so important that you do not see this sacrament as an end, but as a beginning. We as that community of the faithful cannot afford to lose you; you challenge us, you push us from our complacency and stir up the Holy Spirit within us to remind us who we are. You lead us to the kingdom. Your commitment at this time is not only between you and God but involves us as well. We not only pray for you and support you but call you to inspire us, to make us grow.

In fact, all of our young people who are experiencing life's transitions at this time; graduations, change of schools, change of classes, promotions, entering the work force, should know that we lift you before God. We pray for you and support you, but selfishly expect you not to forget us or leave us behind. We ask you to hold us in prayer as well. We depend on your prayers as you depend on ours. The energies of your beginnings energize us to move forward.

These beginnings and transitions happen in the spring of the year to remind us of the ongoing shifts and re-creations that God urges to participate in. It is the renewal of the earth that He always promises. We join Him in the re-creation of the world. There is a dying that takes place, a grieving of what once was, but we acknowledge that as we face the sun. We always face the sun.

On behalf of our faith community I sincerely congratulate those to be confirmed next week, all the recent graduates and those soon graduating, all of our young brothers and sisters moving on to new stages in their lives. And I humbly ask all of you to pray for us in your faith community who have worked in the vineyard for a while. We need your prayers; we need your love and support. Your presence is so important us; you are important to us. We see you as God sees you, precious and beloved gift. You lead us to the Father's kingdom, and that means we owe you a great deal.

Congratulations! May God's blessings continue to shower You with grace and love., with happiness and joy. May the power of the Risen Jesus lead you to His Sacred Heart where you will discover your truest self.
