From the Desk of Msgr. Harrington...

“O Lord, you have probed me and you know me; you know when I sit and when I stand; you understand my thoughts from afar. My journeys and my rest you scrutinize, with all my ways you are familiar. Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, you know the whole of it. Behind me and before me, you hem me in and rest your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; too lofty for me to attain.”

Psalm 139 is one of those beautiful prayers where the psalmist speaks from the heart. To know God is to know that God knows each and every one of us. He knows and loves us deeply. There is no moment where His presence is removed from our past, present or future. To pray the words of the psalm means that we understand His union with us and are not threatened by His knowledge of us but remain grateful for the Father’s bond with His beloved children. He knows, and we are grateful for the knowledge, not ashamed that He reads the secrets of our hearts.

Praying with the psalms gives us the opportunity to honestly approach the Father in thanksgiving, in petition, in anxiety, in despair, in gratitude and joy.

Some days we want to pray a psalm of thanksgiving. Other days we might want to us a psalm that speaks of the hurt that we feel, and we cannot understand why this is happening to us. It is as if the psalms themselves give voice to the secrets of our hearts. Some days we feel safe and secure, and other days we feel abandoned and rejected. The entirety of the psalter assures us that no matter what we are experiencing we can still communicate with God and open our hearts to His grace.

“Where can I go from your spirit? From your presence where can I flee? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I sink to the nether world, you are present there. If I take the wings of the dawn, if I settle the farthest limits of the sea, even there your hand shall guide me, and your right hand hold me fast. If I say, ‘Surely the darkness shall hide me, and night shall be my light’ – for you the darkness itself is not dark, and night shines as day. Darkness and light are the same.”

This connectedness that we have with God is our salvation. This refusal on God’s part to ever turn from us is what gives us life. There simply is no place for us to hide from the wonder of His presence. This is His decision, not ours. He is God; we are not.

“Truly you have formed my inmost being; you knit me in my mother’s womb. I give you thanks that I am fearfully, wonderfully made; wonderful are your works. When I was made in secret, when I was fashioned in the depths of the earth. Your eyes have seen my actions; in your book they are all written; my days were limited before one of them existed. How weighty are your designs, O God, how vast the sum of them! Were I to recount them, they would outnumber the sands; did I reach the end of them, I would still be with you.”

“Probe me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts; see if my way is crooked, and lead me to the way of old.”
